Down Payment

After confirmation of admission, students are required to submit a down payment on tuition of €200 within 30 days in order to guarantee their seat. The down payment is then deducted from the total amount due. This amount is refundable if the students don't pass the Baccalaureate exam.

Invoicing

Students who choose the full payment plan are invoiced before the beginning of each academic year and payment is due by July 31st for Year 1 students, respectively by September 15th for Year 2 and Year 3 students.

Students who choose one of the instalment plans are invoiced monthly and payment is due by the 15th of each month.

In case of withdrawal before the start of the academic year or if students do not complete the academic year, yearly tuition will be charged fully or partially, according to the school's withdrawal policy.

Should a student suspend or repeat an academic year, the latest fees apply. An invoice shall be issued for the academic year to be joined or repeated, with the tuition of the new session.
