Entry requirements:

Academic Background

Students must hold a bachelor's degree in hospitality, tourism or a business management-related subject from a recognised university or any Bachelor's degree plus a minimum of 5 years of evidenced work experience at managerial level within the hospitality or tourism industries.

English Requirements

All students without English as a first language must hold at least IELTS 6 or equivalent. We also present the option of taking the Duolingo English Test, which requires a minimum score of 105 points.

Interview

All candidates undergo an interview assessing their eligibility for the programme*.

*AHA graduates with either a Level 6 CTH qualification or a BA (Hons) in Hospitality or Business are exempt from the interview and the English requirements.
