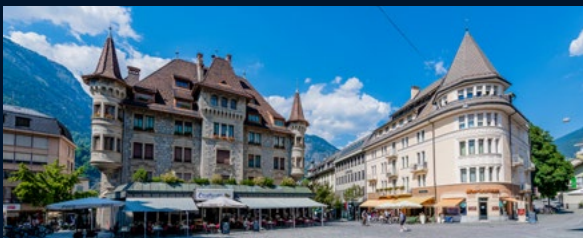
LE BOUVERET CAMPUS
